REGISTRATION

Pre-registration required.

<u>Health</u>. Any exhibitor showing at the Warren County Farmers Fair must be in compliance with New Jersey Division of Animal Health recommendations for New Jersey fairs, shows and sales. All animals must be free from infectious or contagious disease.

- a. A valid (official) Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) signed by an accredited New Jersey Veterinarian must accompany all native New Jersey Animals. The CVI must indicate that all animals of the species to be exhibited on the exhibitor's premises have been observed by a veterinarian and found to be free of any signs of infectious or contagious diseases. The official New Jersey Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection is valid for thirty (30) days in New Jersey. Cattle originating from other states must be accompanied by an official interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection in compliance with New Jersey's import regulations. All domestic animals requiring CVI for exhibition must be individually identified by one of the acceptable species methods and it must be listed on the health certificate. If any additional identification is present, it should also be listed. CVI must be checked by Fair director and/or veterinarian.
- b. All animals which are eligible for an approved USDA rabies vaccination should be current on rabies vaccination, and proof of vaccination by a veterinarian should be provided.
- c. New Jersey exhibitors do not need brucellosis or tuberculosis certificates.
- d. All female animals equal to or greater than four months of age should be calf hood vaccinated, but this is not required for Northeast animals. All animals must be current on Bovine Respiratory Disease complex (shipping fever) vaccination, which includes at least IBRK, PI3, BVD, and BRSV with dates of inoculation and product name recorded on the health certificate. It is strongly recommended that all animals exhibited be vaccinated against rabies. These will be checked with the registration papers. Check with your veterinarian for any updated tests that are required by the New Jersey Department of Animal Health.
- e. Animals not meeting health regulations will be asked to leave the grounds.

Rules

- Production forms of each milking animal must be presented before 8:00 AM on the day of the show. All exhibitors will pay an entry fee of \$5.00 for each animal. Post entries will not be accepted after 8:00 AM on August 5, 2016. The entry fee allows the animal to be entered in as many classes as the exhibitor sees fit. Checks should be made payable to the Warren County Farmers Fair Association and are due <u>JULY 1, 2016</u>. ALL SPECIAL CLASS ENTRIES WILL BE MADE BY <u>JULY 1, 2016</u>. NO POST ENTRIES OR SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR CLASSES 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 AND ALL SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES.
- Exhibitors will receive one exhibitor pass for the back gate to gain access to loading and unloading of animals.
- 3. No Animals are to be tied in the Red and White Show Building.
- 4. All animals must be on the grounds by 8:00 AM the morning of the show. All exhibitors are asked to remain on the grounds until 7:00 PM the evening of the show. Animals may remain through Saturday, August 6, 2016, however, UPON REMOVAL OF YOUR ANIMALS AREA MUST BE CLEANED UP BY PUSHING DEBRIS INTO THE CENTER AISLE.
- 5. Registration papers will be checked by a Fair director and/or veterinarian. If your registration papers have not been received by this date, it is advisable to call your breed association for verification of registry and/or transfer. Proof of registered animals in owner's name is required. Registration papers with agreeing markings or tattoos must be available. Animals must be registered and/or transferred and entered in the name of the owner. Each animal entered can only be entered in one of the age classes. For example, a cow entered in the 5-year-old class may not be entered in the 125,000 classes or dry cow class. All milking fall yearlings will compete in the Junior Two-Year-Old Class. All cows entered in milking or dry cow classes must have been fresh at least once, except for two year olds, which will be shown in their respective two-year-old class.
- 6. The Warren County Farmers Fair Association will provide bedding for exhibitors. It is up to the exhibitors to bring feed, hay, utensils and equipment. Also it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to feed and water their animals.
- 7. All walkways must be kept clear of equipment, supplies, debris, etc., during your entire stay at the Warren County Farmers Fair. At no time may any walkways be roped off in the exhibitor barns.

- 8. Medical waste must not be put in with the manure or trashcans on the grounds. Please dispose of needles properly by taking them home.
- 9. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed and to accept conditions as provided without controversy. This display is held for educational purposes, and animals must be kept in show shape.
- 10. Exhibitors shall be neatly dressed when exhibiting and wear clean clothes.
- 11. The Fair directors and/or veterinarian reserves the right to bar from any show unruly animals or animals of decidedly inferior conformation and type or animals not meeting the health standards.
- 12. Bathroom and shower facilities located in the livestock area are available to all exhibitors.
- 13. The Open Colored Breed Show is open to any breeder from any county or state.
- 14. Premiums will paid by check and mailed after Fair.
- 15. Premiums will be paid in all type classes, special classes and showmanship classes.
- 16. Trophies will be given for Junior & Reserve Junior, Senior & Reserve Senior, Grand and Reserve Grand Champions in each breed.
- 17. The Supreme Champion will receive a Premium of \$100.00 and a trophy.
- 18. All SPECIAL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE MADE BY <u>JULY 1, 2016</u>. NO POST OR SUBSTITUTIONS ENTRIES FOR THESE CLASSES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 19. All exhibitors are responsible to carry a manure bucket to and from the barns. All exhibitors must clean out their area immediately before leaving the grounds; failure to do so may result in loss premiums.
- 20. Stalls will be assigned by the Fair directors. Buildings will NOT be altered in any way.

- 10. Fall Yearling born 9/1/14 through 11/30/14 Milking fall yearlings will compete in the junior 2 year old class.

Senior Female:

All animals entered in milking or dry cow classes MUST have been fresh at least once. (Except for 2-year-old animals)

- 12. Junior 2 year old born 3/1/14 through 8/31/14
- 13. Senior 2 year old born 9/1/13 through 2/28/13
- 14. Junior 3 year old born 3/1/13 through 8/31/13
- 15. Senior 3 year old born 9/1/12 through 2/28/13
- 16. Four Year old born 9/1/11 through 8/31/10
- 17. Five Year old born 9/1/10 through 8/31/11
- 18. Aged Cows born before 8/31/10
- 19. Junior Dry Cow born on or after 9/1/11 (2 through 4 year old)
- 20. Senior Dry Cow born on or before 8/31/11 (5 years and older)
- 21. 125,000 lb Cow Certified by DHIA Supervisor
- 22. Senior and Reserve Senior Champion
- 23. Grand and Reserve Grand Champion
- 24. Type and Production (must be DHIA or DHIR certified) with official cow sheet attached to P/T form.
- 25. Produce of Dam two animals: one or more owners; same dam
- 26. Dam and Offspring

SPECIAL CLASSES – All breeds will compete against each other in the following classes.

- 27. **SUPREME CHAMPION** The Grand Champion of each breed will return to the ring. A Supreme Champion will be selected. The Supreme Champion will receive \$100.00 and a Trophy.
- 28. Best three females Bred and owned by family exhibitors and residing on same farm; one group per farm.
- 29. Dairy Herd three animals owned by family exhibitor and residing on the same farm.
- 30. Junior Get-of-Sire three females all from the same sire born on after September 1, 2014.
- 31. Senior Get-of-Sire three females all from the same sire born on or before August 31, 2014.
- 32. Jersey Special two animals that are bred, own and shown, born and raised in New Jersey by the same exhibitor who resides in the State of New Jersey.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES: <u>YOUTH</u> only animals shown in this class must have been shown in a previous class WITHOUT adult assistance. Ages will go by the age that you turn in the show calendar year. For example: (Your birthday is 10/95 – and you will turn 21. You are showing as a 21 year old and eligible for class 37 in the youth showmanship class.)

- 33. Up to 7 years old
- 34. 8 years to 11 years old.
- 35. 12 years to 15 years old
- 36. 16 years to 18 years old
- 37. 19 years to 21 years old
- 38. ADULT Showmanship Class anyone may enter, however, the animal in this class must have been shown in a type class.
