Rules

1. One entry per class with the exception of class 9 and class 25 where two (2) entries are allowed.
2. All entries must be correctly identified or they will be disqualified.
3. All plant material should be in good condition. No diseased or insect infested plants will be accepted. The chairman has the right to refuse any entry.
4. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor and can not be connected to a commercial business.
5. Display jars are 4" & 6 ½ "glasses, pint size mason jars and quart size mason jars. Please cut entries accordingly.
6. One all week pass will be given for every 10 entries.
7. Awards will be attached to entries. Award and entries must be picked up on August 6th between 7:00-8:00 PM. Awards and entries not picked up at that time will become the property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair.

Judging

1. Entries will be judged on uniformity, appearance, uniqueness of variety, freedom from insects & disease and/or other damage.

Division 1 – Annuals

1. Zinnia–3 stems–one variety
2. Marigold (Tagetes)-3 stems-one variety
3. Sunflower (Helianthus)-1 stem
4. Cleome (Spider flower)-1 stem
5. Petunia-3 stems-one variety
6. Coleus-3 colorful leaf stems-one variety
7. Celosia (Cockscomb or plume)-3 stems-one variety
8. Dahlia-1 stem
9. Other Annuals-3 stems-one variety of any annual not listed-flower type must be specified
10. Window Box or Patio Planter-filled with annuals
11. Hanging Basket-a single or group of annuals

Division 2 – Perennials/Bulbs

12. Gladiolus-1 stem
13. Hosta-3 stems-one variety
14. Liatris (Gay Feather)-3 stems-one variety
15. Lily-1 stem
16. Butterfly Bush (Buddleia)-3 stems-one variety
17. Phlox-3 stems-one variety
18. Rudbeckia (Black-Eyed Susan)-3 stems-one variety
19. Yarrow-3 stems-one variety
20. Cone Flower (Echinacia)-3 stems-one variety

21. Hydrangea-3 stems-one variety
22. Succulent-cut or potted
23. Sedum-3 stems-one variety
24. Other Perennial-3 stems-one variety of any perennial not listed-flower type must be specified
25. Fragrant Perennial-3 stems-any variety that is known for its extremely pleasant fragrance-flower type must be specified
26. Dried Floral Wreath-decorate any type of wreath with dried flowers - Flowers must have been grown by exhibitor
27. Fresh Floral Arrangement-cut fresh flowers in a container - Flowers must have been grown by exhibitor
