RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The theme will be "Life in 1937."
2. The overall size will be 18'x36' and a frame will be made using 1x2" wood.
3. Contestants can construct their scarecrow from the following materials: straw, hay, burlap, clothing, fabric, farm products (corn husk, etc.) to fit this year's theme.
4. No items such as tiki torches, gas powered generators or any other flammable objects are allowed. No rubber, plastic or store bought masks are allowed.
5. All pieces of clothing must be securely attached by sewing together or by using wire, safety pins, glue, string or other similar supplies.
6. Scarecrows must have a face, be in good taste, and not show anything considered scary.
7. Only one entry per exhibitor will be allowed.

New in 2017: Scarecrows will become property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair as they will be displayed throughout the Fairgrounds for the week of the Fair.

Each exhibitor will receive a one day complimentary pass for their entry.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

You will be judged on theme originality, creativity, craftsmanship, detail, facial features and smile factor, if applicable.

AWARDS:

- 1st place – Trophy and \$25
- 2nd place – Trophy and \$15
- 3rd-5th place – Ribbon
