- 4. Class identification is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Volunteers and committee members will not choose the class in which a specimen is entered. Only the judge has the authority to disqualify an entry if misidentified on the entry tag.
- 5. All entries must be clean but not washed.
- 6. An all week complimentary pass will be given for every 10 entries.
- 1. Entries will be disposed of during the week as they begin to decompose in order to maintain a healthy and appealing display. Plate and tag will be kept on display throughout Fair week. Plates and tags are the property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair Association.
- 7. Entries become the property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair.
- 8. Awards must be picked up on Sunday, August 6th between 1:00 PM and 2:00 PM. Any awards not picked up at this time become the property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair Association.

Judging:

1. Vegetables will be weighed by judge with the assistance of chair committee following registration. Heaviest specimen in each class will be awarded 1st place. No other placings will be awarded.
