### Official Photos

All **Queen** contestants must call Bob Lubowicki to set up at a time by JUNE 25<sup>th</sup> to have your official photo taken. He can be reached 908-303-2328. Photo sessions must be scheduled AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

All **Princess** contestants must provide an 8x10 photo OR a photo that can legally be enlarged into an 8x10. Photos do not need to be professional. Photos must be received no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> in an envelope clearly marked Princess Photo 2020 and addressed to Kelley Smith, c/o Harmony Township Municipal Building, 3003 Belvidere Road, Phillipsburg, NJ 08865.

Queen contestants must wear an evening gown.

Princess contestants must wear blue shorts. A t-shirt will be provided.

### Rehearsal - MANDATORY

All contestants are required to stay the duration of the rehearsal. Princess contestants should bring items necessary to perform their talent (i.e. music, instrument, props, etc.)

CDs of your music are preferred. You can email Emma Cogle a copy of your song and she will compile all of them onto one CD. ([ecogle14@gmail.com](mailto:ecogle14@gmail.com)) If you are bringing your own, please label CD with your name and track number.

Available microphones include: lapel mic, handheld mic, standing mic and headset.

Escorts are required to attend rehearsal and contest.

All attire must be age appropriate. (This is not a pageant and extravagant dresses aren't necessary for princess contestants. We recommend sun or Easter type dresses.)

## **Competition**

A shed by the dance floor will be available for princess contestants to change attire throughout the competition. Contestants are encouraged to arrive with ample time prior to line up to place belongings in the shed.

Escorts must wear long sleeve shirt & tie. A jacket is optional depending on the temperature that day.

Queen contestants meet Pier Semanchik on Strykers Road at the Center Back Gate at 7:00 PM. Contestants will line up in numerical order with escorts in convertible cars (No tractors, pick-up trucks or Jeeps) Cars should line up on Strykers Road at 6:30 PM.

Princess contestants meet Vicki Smith by stage on the Dance floor at 7:00 PM. Contestants will line up in numerical order with escorts.

Flowers will be provided to all queen and princess contestants.

All contestants are required to stay after the competition to have pictures taken. After the Fair photographer is through taking the official photos family members will be given a few minutes to take their pictures. Please do not interfere with the Fair photographer.

Queen Contestants dismissed from the stage with their escorts to prepare for random question portion (you may change gowns at this point)

Princess Contestants' talent

Princess Contestants change back into their dress for crowning

Queen Contestants' Random Question Portion

Princesses return to the stage
