***NEW* Arts & Crafts Show Rules:w**

1. All articles must be made after 2025 Warren County Fair by the exhibitor who resides in Warren County.
2. There will be 4 Divisions: Adult, Teen, Youth, and Special Needs.
 - Adult: 18+
 - Teen: 13 to 17 years old.
 - Youth: 3 to 12 years old.
 - Special Needs: Any Age. Defined as those who require tailored services, accommodations, or specialized support for physical, mental, or developmental impairments.
3. Any class can be any theme. Except for the *Theme Classes* which are specified.
4. All items must be **made by the contestant**. Buying an item premade without any alterations unique to the contestant is subject to disqualification. Craft kits and templates are acceptable.
5. An exhibitor may enter **two articles** per class unless otherwise stated.
6. Youth division not open to 4-H members.
7. Exhibitor will receive two day passes for every 5 entries and 1 weeklong pass for 10 entries.

Please note not all divisions can enter all categories. Refer to the “participating division” column for information on who can participate.

ARTS CATEGORY:

Overall Class	Participating Divisions	Division Class Number	Description
Paintings*	ALL	100 (Adult) 200 (Teen) 300 (Youth) 400 (SN)	Media utilized includes painting substances such as watercolor, acrylic, oil, etc. No diamond painting (see mosaic art). Maximum size 24” x 24”
Drawings*	ALL	101 (Adult) 201 (Teen) 301 (Youth) 401 (SN)	Can be wet or dry media. Media utilized includes drawing substances such as crayon, colored pencils, chalk, charcoal, graphite, markers, ink, gel pens. etc. Maximum size 24” x 24”.
Mosaic	ALL	102 (Adult) 202 (Teen) 302 (Youth) 402 (SN)	Any shape. Pieces must be secured with mortar or adhesive. Material can be stone, glass, etc. Diamond paintings accepted. Maximum size 18” x 18”. Can be in display case.
Ceramic	Teen and Adult Only	103 (Adult) 203 (Teen)	From clay (no air-dry) or other earthen materials. Must be fired. Can be functional such as vases and bowls or decorative. Can be in display case.
Resin Art	Teen and Adult Only	104 (Adult) 204 (Teen)	Use of epoxy or UV resin for glossy artwork. Any material. Not to exceed 18x18. Can be in display case.

Overall Class	Participating Divisions	Division Class Number	Description
Air Dry Clay	Youth and Special Needs Only	305 (Youth) 405 (SN)	Any shape, size, or purpose. Can be altered with other art substances such as paint. Can be in display case.
Glass	Adult Only	106	Primarily made of glass materials. No jewelry (separate category in crafts). Stained, blown, or fuse accepted. Can be displayed in a case. MUST be able to stand or lay on its own.
Sculpture	Adult Only	107	3D art that is NOT ceramic. Metalwork, stone/wood carvings, or 3D printed. Can be in display case.

***Entries will not be accepted unless they meet the following specifications:** All painting and drawing entries **MUST** BE framed and ready for hanging. Wood/Plastic frames with wire/eye hooks. No string allowed. PLEASE NO GLASS OR HEAVY FRAMES! Support and secure your artwork.

Floral	Teen and Adult ONLY	108 (Adult) 208 (Teen)	Includes silk and dried floral arrangements. Not to exceed 16x16x24.
Lego Construction	Youth and Special Needs ONLY	309 (Youth) 409 (SN)	Any creation, original or template. Not to exceed 16x16x16.

Overall Class	Participating Divisions	Division Class Number	Description
Decorated Wearables**	ALL	110 (Adult) 210 (Teen) 310 (Youth) 410 (SN)	Wearables that are pre-made (if making original wearables see handwork competition). Must be altered by contestant with any art such as tie-dye, graphic design, embellishment, etc. Can be displayed in a case.
Jewelry**	ALL	111 (Adult) 211 (Teen) 311 (Youth) 411 (SN)	Jewelry originally constructed by contestant such as stringing, beading, knotting, etc. Can be displayed in a case.
Upcycling	ALL	112 (Adult) 212 (Teen) 312 (Youth) 412 (SN)	Original creation of old products into new. Any purpose. Turn your trash into treasure! Not to exceed 18x18x18.
Paper**	ALL	113 (Adult) 213 (Teen) 313 (Youth) 413 (SN)	Original creation of 2D or 3D objects through techniques like cutting, folding, gluing, layering, and molding.
Yard**	ALL	114 (Adult) 214 (Teen) 314 (Youth) 414 (SN)	Any decorative, functional, or found-object item placed in an outdoor space such as birdhouses, ceramic pots, windchimes, etc. Any material. Not to exceed 16x16x16.

**Up to THREE entries per contestant.

Special Theme: <i>"Made in America"</i>	ALL	ALL REGISTER AND COMPETE UNDER #515	Use of ANY art/craft materials related to theme. Not to exceed 18x18x18.
Special Theme: <i>"The American Farmer"</i>	ALL	ALL REGISTER AND COMPETE UNDER #516	Use of ANY art/craft materials related to theme. Not to exceed 18x18x18.

Arts and Crafts/Awards must be picked Up SUNDAY, AUGUST 2ND between 12 and 1:30 p.m.

NO AWARDS CAN BE PICKED UP EARLIER OR DURING THE FAIR.
