Rules:

1. All herbs must have been selected and homegrown by the exhibitor and be cut to a minimum of 3" and maximum of 15" (excluding chives).
2. One entry per class.
3. One division will include youth and adult.
4. There will be listed categories for each type of herb.
5. All entries must contain the exact number according to the category/class.
6. Three stems without roots constitute an entry display unless otherwise stated in the category.
7. Exhibitor must select their own specimens. Committee chairmen will not choose any specimens to be exhibited.
8. For "Any Other Named Variety" classes, variety name must be specified on the entry tag.
9. Entries will be displayed in jars provided by the Warren County Farmers' Fair Association.
10. Exhibitors entering 10 or more items will receive one all-week pass.
11. Committee will dispose of unhealthy entries during the week to maintain a pleasing display.
12. Awards must be picked up on Sunday, August 2nd between 12:00 PM and 1:30 PM in the Home & Garden Building. Any awards and exhibits not picked up will become property of the Warren County Farmers' Fair Association. For special circumstances please email farmersfairwc@gmail.com.
13. Ribbons and rosettes are awarded per category.

Judging:

1. Judging will be based on, but not limited to, the following areas: disease free specimens, fragrance and flavor, healthy color of variety entered, lack of blemished injury and standards of the species assuming they are grown for culinary, medicinal and /or fragrance uses.
2. If a specimen is one that blooms all season or is grown mainly for flower parts then it will be judged according to its species. Other herbs may be penalized at judge's discretion if entered in bloom.
